Purpose: Youth baseball is player pitch baseball. This means that the youth will pitch the baseball to the batter. **Our emphasis is to promote fun, fair play, skill development and teamwork.**



Teams: Teams will be organized by the child's age group. We will try to accommodate coaches' and parents' requests to have their children playing on the same team as their friend, but we do not want to overload coaches and teams. **There is no guarantee your child will be on the team requested.** Youth Baseball is a recreational league and there will be no competitive teams allowed. Teams may be combined due to the number of registration.

Practice: Practices will be held at the coaches' discretion. Equipment will be available to coaches for use. The Coaches are responsible for arranging practices for their teams.

Organization Day: Organization day will be held Tuesday, April 7th at Copperview Recreation Center Softball Fields. This will give participants a chance to meet their team mates, coaches and receive information.

Games: Games are played on Saturdays. Games will begin April 18th. Games will be at the Copperview Recreation Center Softball Fields (8446 South Harrison St.).
