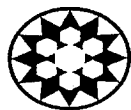


Ski & Snowboard Program

Transportation:

PROGRAM RULES: PLEASE READ

- 1 PLEASE REVIEW AND FOLLOW ALL GUIDELINES ON THE PARENT INFORMATION SHEET.
- 2 This program is in no way sponsored by the school. Please direct all questions to Salt Lake County at 424-0621.
- 3 Transportation provided by chartered bus or van. Students must ride scheduled transportation to and from Brighton and may not go home with family or friends. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4 No requests to ski or ride with specific individuals will be guaranteed.
- 5 Students that miss a lesson can not fill their place with a friend/relative. No refunds will be given once the program has started. There are no make up days for missed sessions. Parents must call and notify the supervisor when a child will miss a session—otherwise the bus may wait for them and get a late start. 424-0621
- 6 Please check equipment – make sure it is in good working condition prior to use—we are not responsible for injury due to equipment failure.
- 7 Individuals are responsible for providing their own ski/snowboard equipment or arranging for their own rentals.
- 8 Label skis, poles, snowboards, and other equipment and personal items **clearly** with the child's name.
- 9 Salt Lake County Parks & Recreation will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 10 Failure to adhere to these rules or inappropriate behavior will result in student being dropped from the program without a refund.
- 11 If sessions are cancelled by Holladay-Lion's Recreation Staff because of adverse weather or road conditions the make-up day will be announced.

PARENTAL STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT ASSUMPTION OF RISK, LIABILITY RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND REFUND POLICY

1. Release and Indemnification: I hereby recognize and acknowledge that my child's participation in recreational activities may involve bodily and/or emotional injury to myself and/or my child. In consideration of my child being able to participate in such events I for myself, my child, my heirs, my executors and administrators, hereby voluntarily and knowingly indemnify and hold harmless, defend, release, waive and discharge Salt Lake County, Boyne/USA, its officers, and employees, and volunteers from any and all suits, claims or liability, including negligence based on any injury except that caused solely by the willful misconduct of Salt Lake County, that may result from my child's participation in Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation activities. In addition, I agree that I or my insurance company will pay for medical, hospitalization or any other expenses resulting from my child's participation.
2. Refund Policy: As per Salt Lake County policy and procedures, the Parks and Recreation Division may withhold 25% of the refund (program registration fee) for administrative costs. All refunds must be requested in person and accompanied with a written refund request. No refunds shall be given after the first day of the program.
3. Collections: I agree to pay Salt Lake County all costs incurred, together with reasonable attorney's fees in the event that my account is referred to the Salt Lake County Attorney's Office for collection. I understand that any account delinquent 30 days or more will be turned over to the Salt Lake County Attorney for collection.
4. Emergency Treatment: I hereby authorize Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation program staff to act on my behalf in accordance with their best judgment in case of an emergency involving my child, and agree to assume full responsibility for all expenses, medical or otherwise, that may arise there from. I understand that I or my insurance company will pay for such emergency treatment.
5. Equal Opportunity: Salt Lake County Parks & Recreation provides equal opportunity to participate regardless of race, creed, gender, or ability to pay and will, upon request, provide reasonable accommodation to individuals with disabilities.
6. By signing this assumption of risk, liability release, indemnification and refund policy statement, I acknowledge that I have read its contents and disclosure, that I understand its contents and disclosure, and that I agree to its terms.
