Learn To Play Ice Hockey Program For Boys and Girls ages 5-10

Start Smart Program Overview

Ice hockey is a very challenging and lengthy sport to learn. We have developed this program to teach new players the basic skills needed to play in a hockey league with players that may have several years of hockey experience. This **24 week program (4 levels)** will teach your child skating skills, puck skills, positional play, rules, and most importantly, will give them a better sense of confidence before they play in a hockey league. **NEW PLAYERS MAY JOIN LEVEL 2.**

Quick Facts about the Start Smart Program:

- Level 2 classes begin November 16 and end Monday December 21 (no class on 11/25)
- Classes are Monday evenings 5:30-6:15 PM *AND* Wednesdays 6:30-7:15 PM
- Some equipment is required. Please see the back of the flyer for equipment details
- Cost is \$65.00 for each 6 week level
- A free Public Skating/Youth Drop-In Hockey Pass is included with tuition
- A \$10.00 discount for the next level is offered for students that come back to the SLC Sports Complex to skate a minimum of 6 times during the current level
- Each student receives a free hockey jersey and a street hockey ball to practice at home (new players only)
- Parent/Volunteer Coaches are welcome and needed!

Prerequisites: This is a learn to play class, however, students should have some previous skating experience. Students should have passed USFSA Level 3 in the Learn-to-Skate program. However, we are looking for these traits in a beginning skater:

1. Should be beyond the marching phase of skating, both standing still and in motion.
2. Should not need the use of a red walker or must be able to skate without the assistance of the wall.
3. Should be able to stay attentive for a 45 minute lesson with up to 30 skaters and with only 3-4 coaches to supervise.
4. Parents should be willing to bring their child skating once a week to practice!

Parental Statement Agreement Assumption of Risk, Liability, Release and Refund Policy

1. Release: I hereby recognize and acknowledge that my child's participation in recreational activities may involve bodily and/or emotional injury to myself and/or my child being permitted to participate in such events, I, myself, my child, my heirs, my executors and administrators, hereby voluntarily release, waive, discharge Salt Lake County its officers and employees from and all liability except that caused solely by the negligence of Salt Lake County, that may result from my child's participation in Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation activities.
2. Refund Policy: As per Salt Lake County Policy and Procedures, the Parks and Recreation Division may withhold 25% of the program (program registration fee) for administrative costs. All refunds must be requested person and be accompanied with a written refund request. No refund shall be given the first day of program.
3. Collections: I agree to pay Salt Lake County all costs incurred, together with reasonable attorney's fees in event that my account is referred to the Salt Lake County attorney's office for collection.
4. Emergency treatment: I hereby authorize Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation program staff to act in my behalf on accordance with their best judgment in case of an emergency involving my child, and agree to assume full responsibility for all expenses, medical, or otherwise, that may arise there from. I understand that I or my insurance will be billed for such emergency treatment.
